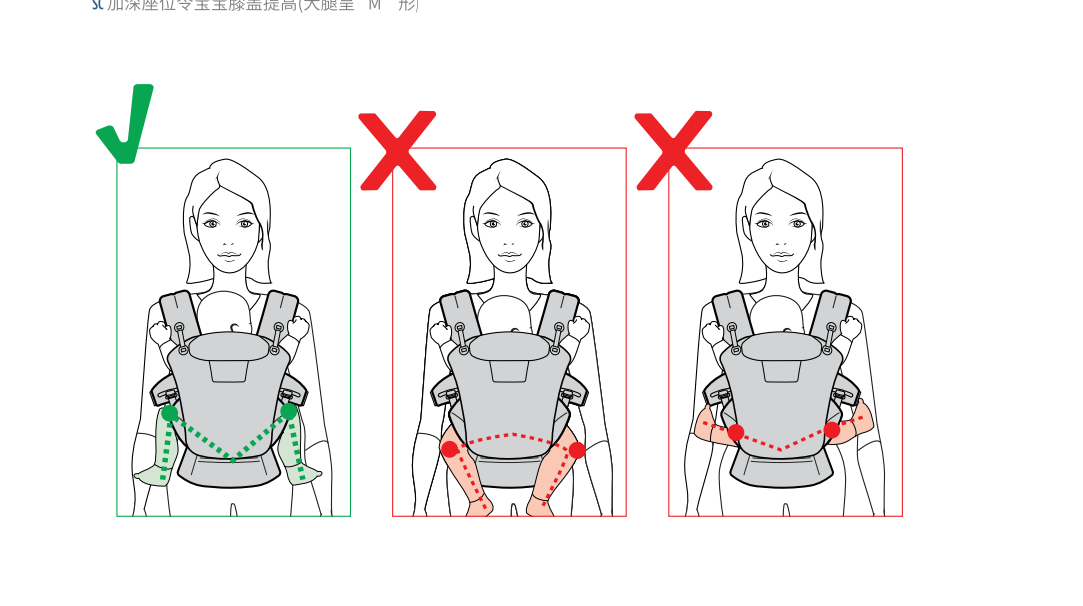


2 BABY POSITIONING CHECKLIST & TIPS

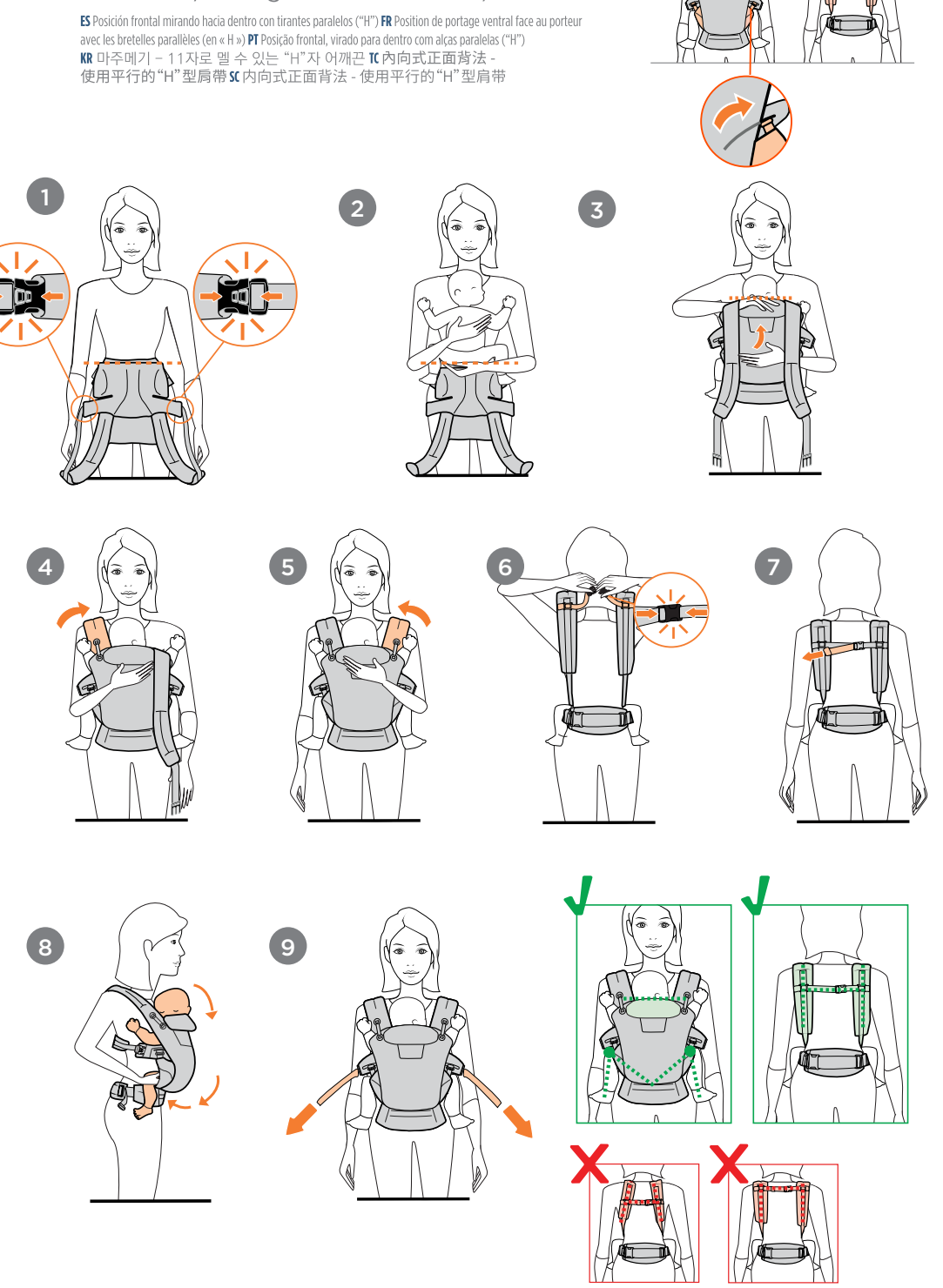
2A Baby close enough to kiss, high on your body



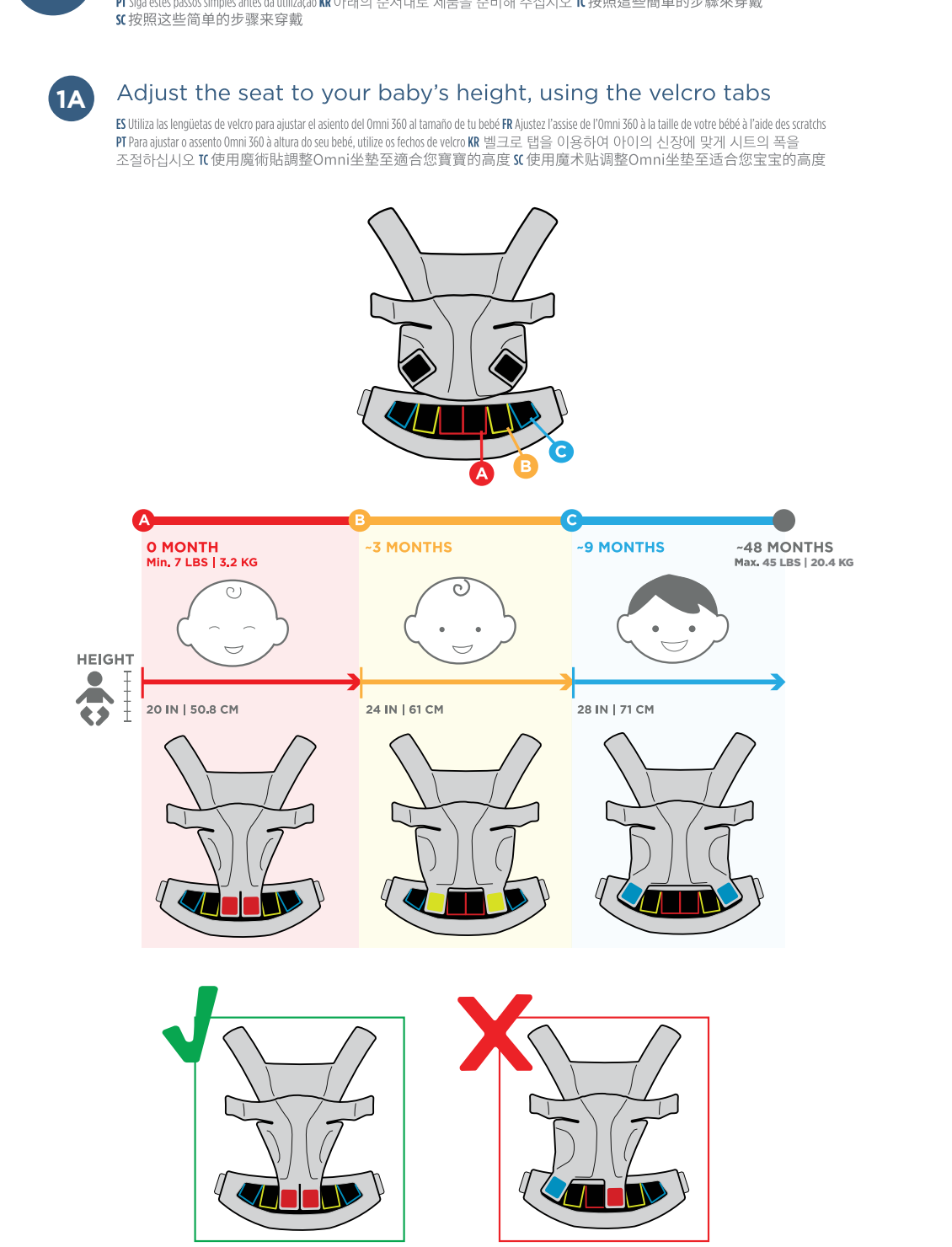
2B Deep seat with knees high



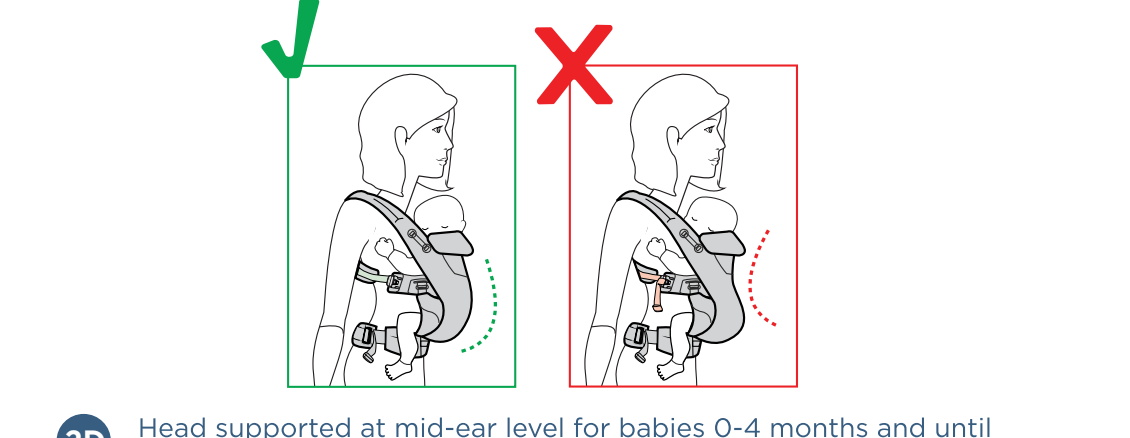
5 FRONT CARRY INWARD-FACING WITH PARALLEL "H" STRAPS



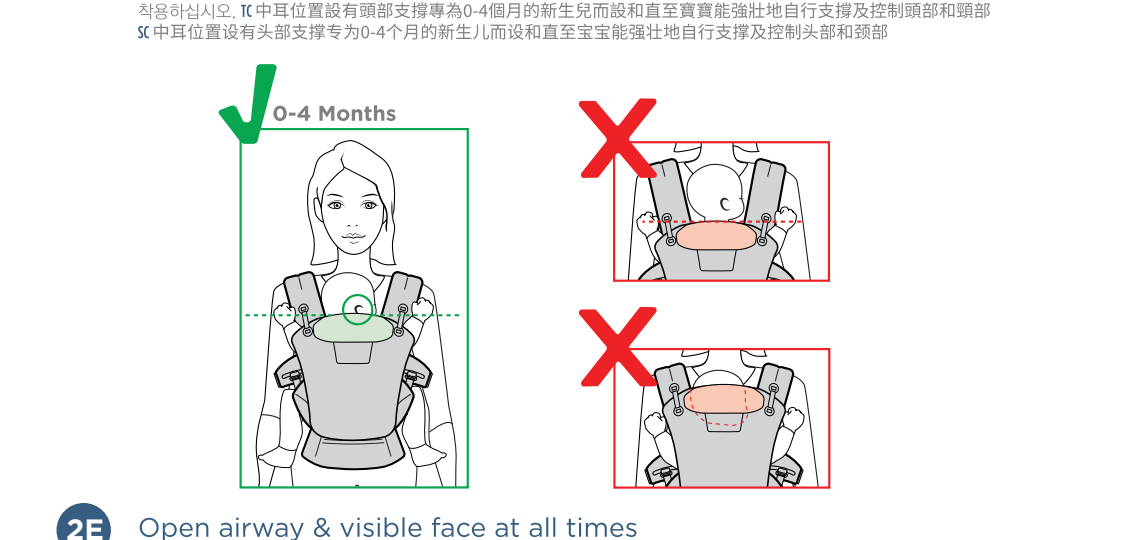
1 FOLLOW THESE EASY STEPS TO GET STARTED



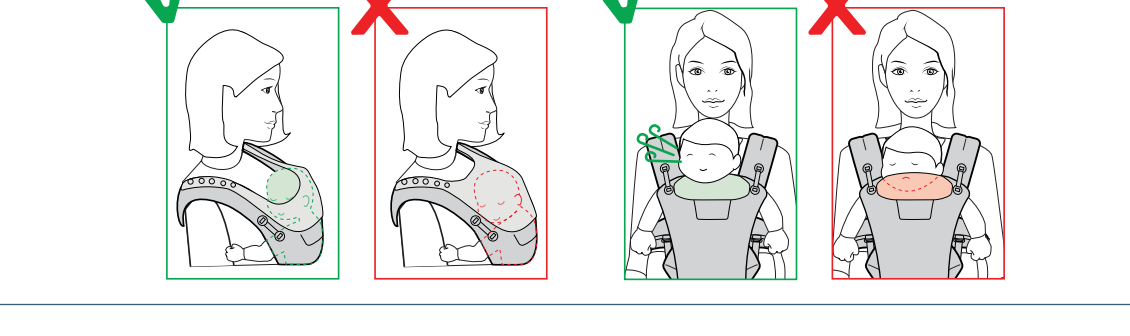
2C Spine in soft, rounded shape



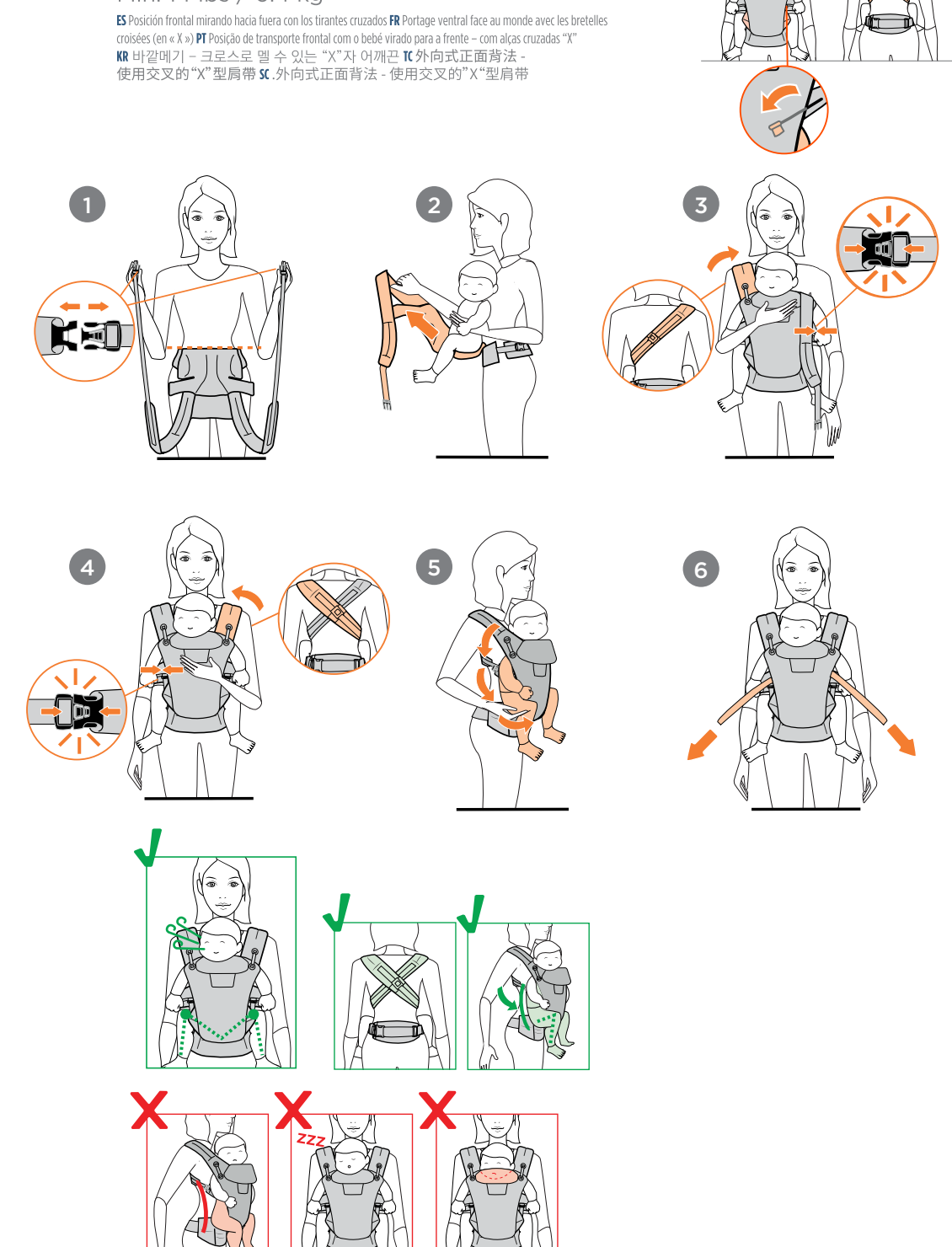
2D Head supported at mid-ear level for babies 0-4 months and until baby has strong head and neck control



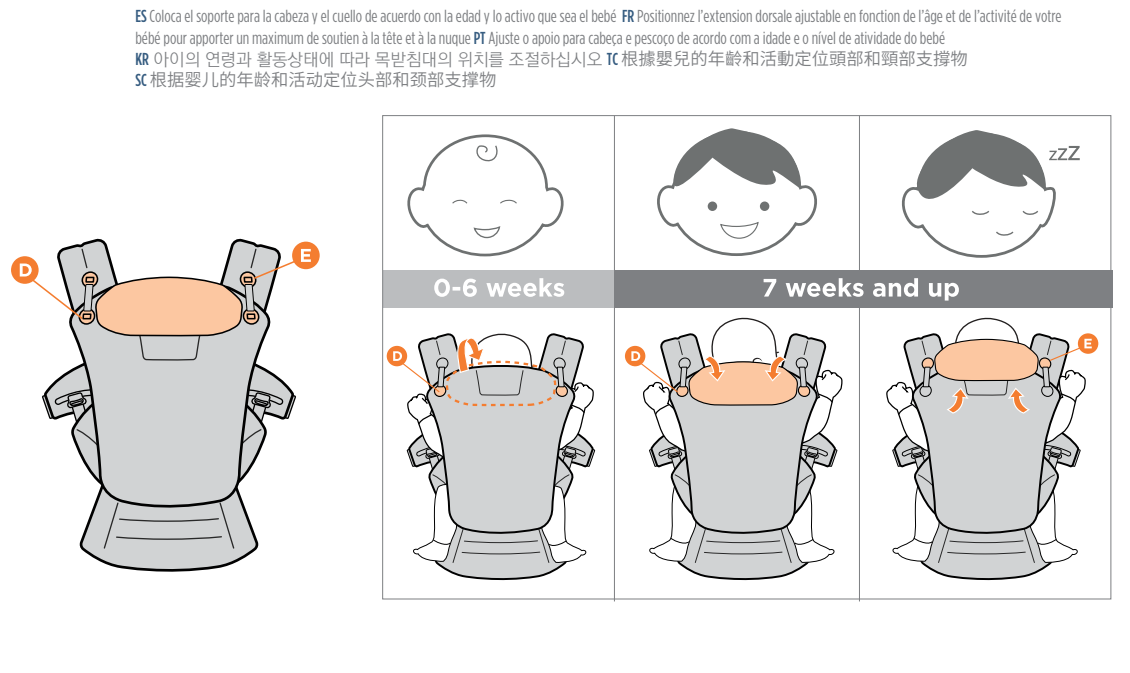
2E Open airway & visible face at all times



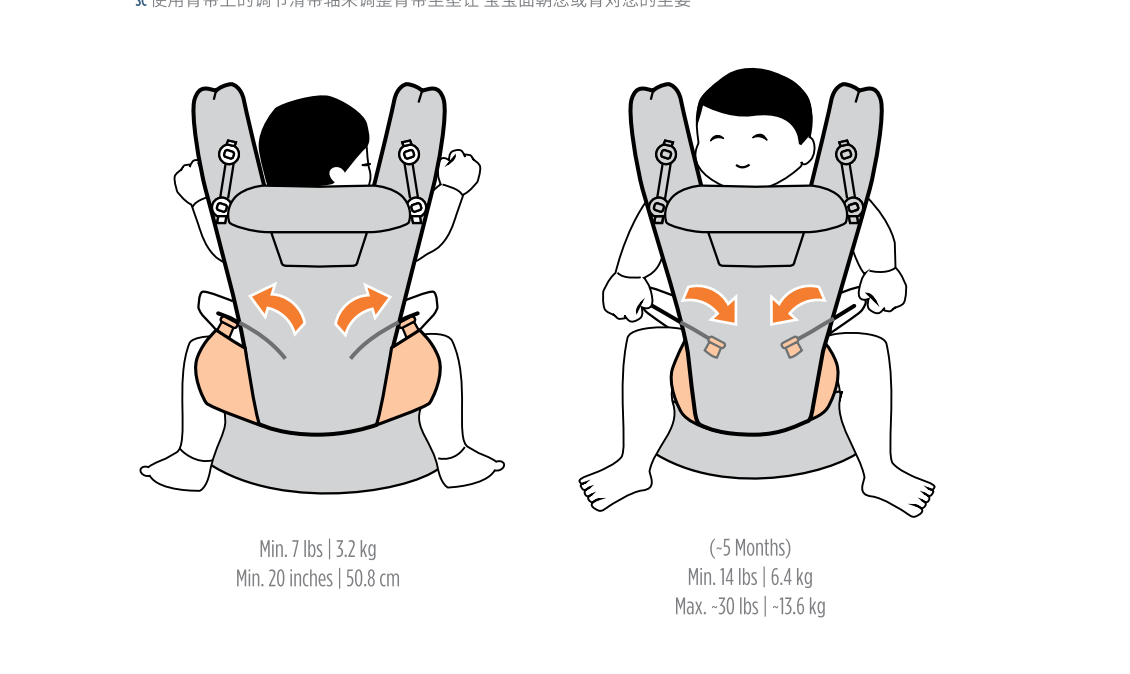
6 FRONT CARRY OUTWARD-FACING WITH CRISSCROSS "X" STRAPS



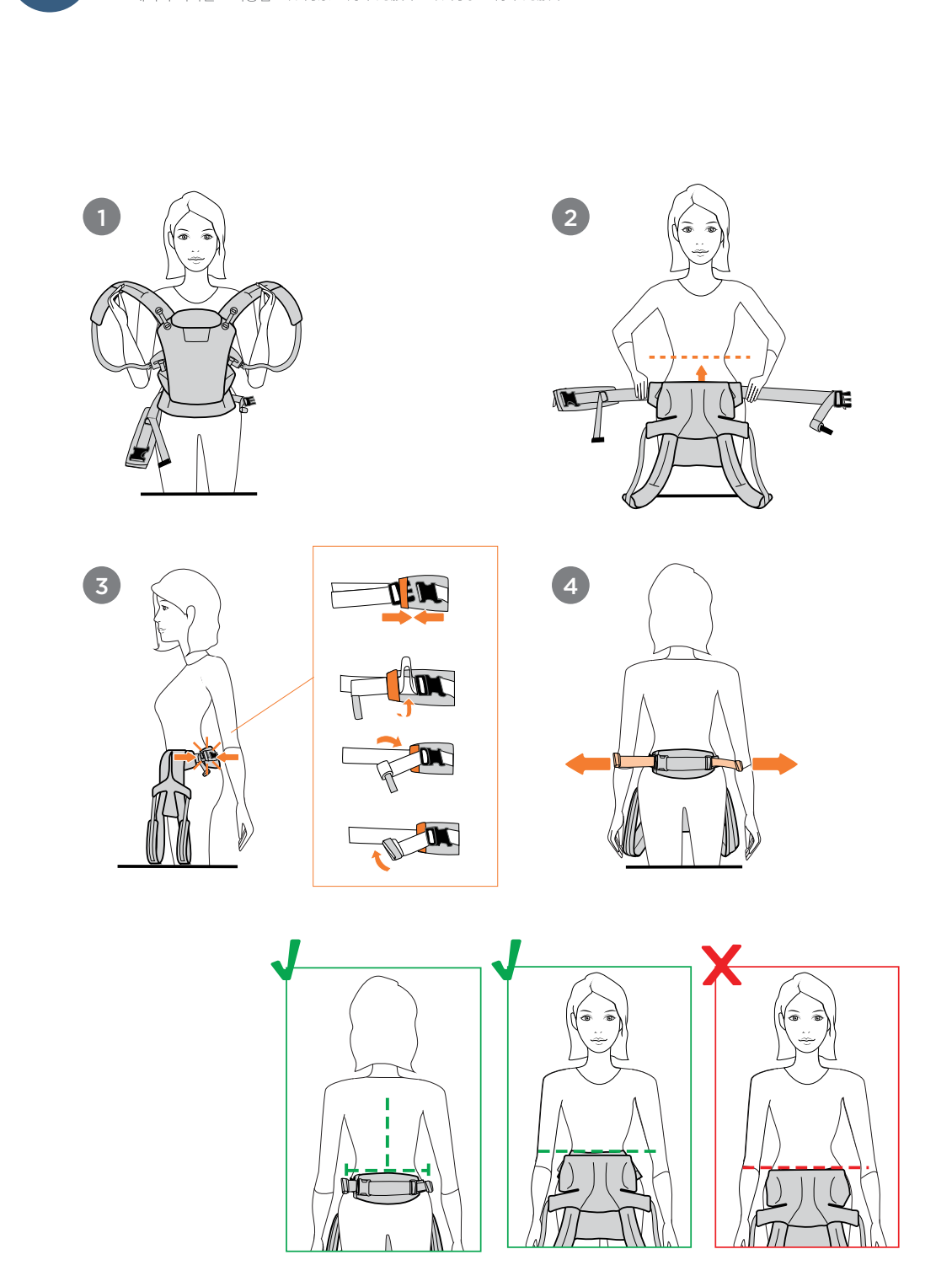
1B Position the head and neck support according to baby's age and activity



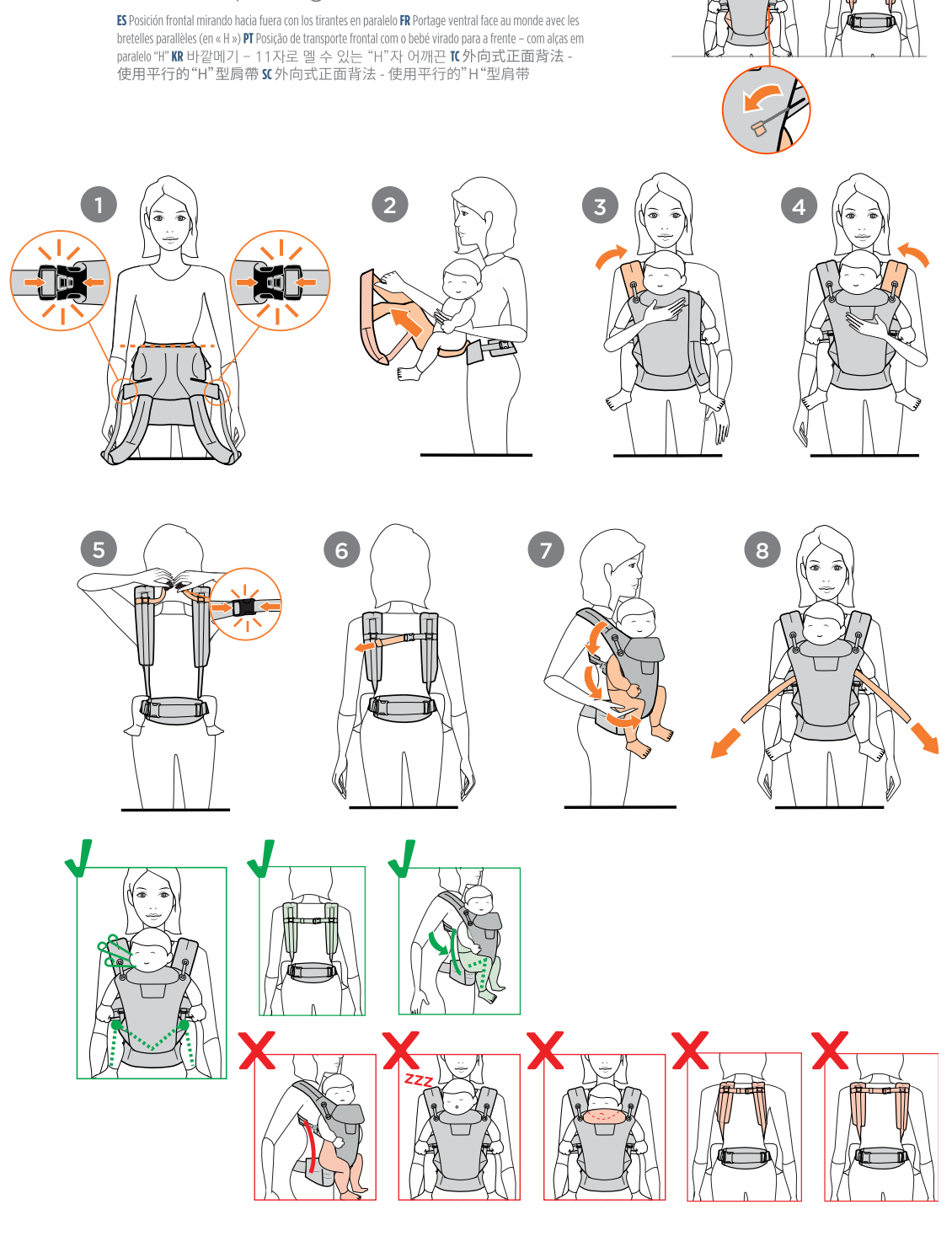
1C Adjust the carrier seat to face baby in or out, using the sliders



3 HOW TO ATTACH THE CARRIER WAISTBELT



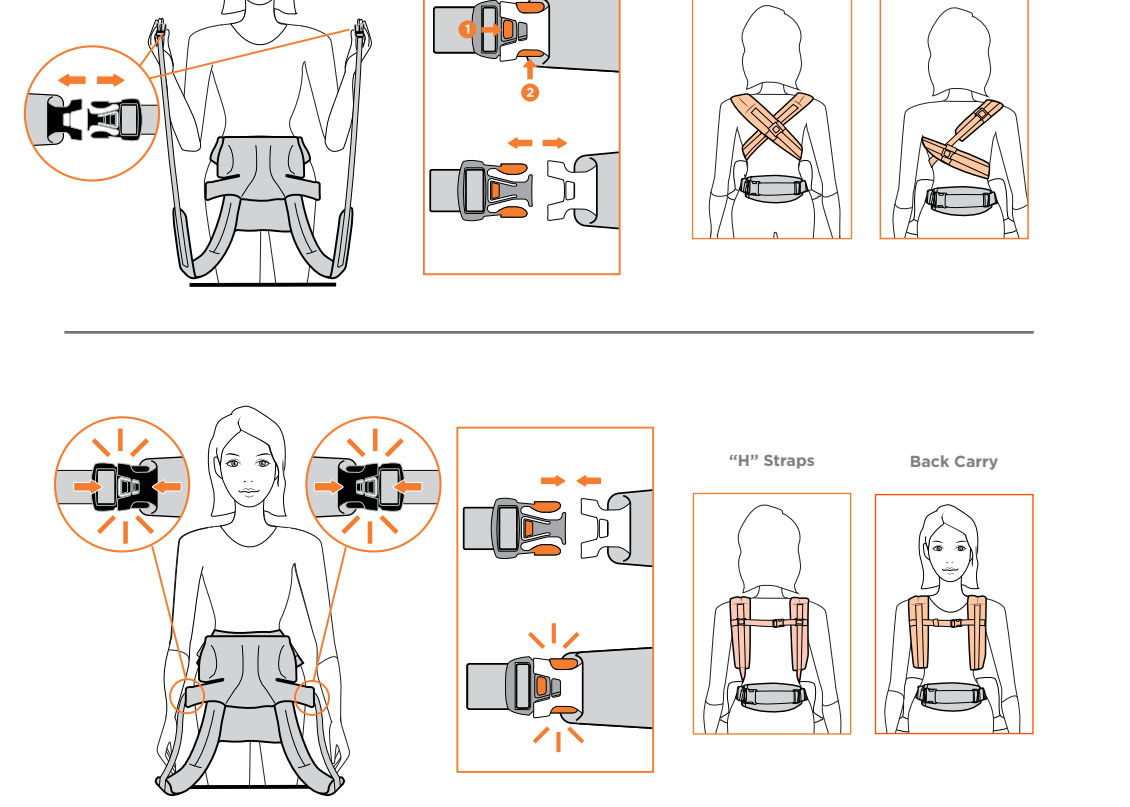
7 FRONT CARRY OUTWARD-FACING WITH PARALLEL "H" STRAPS



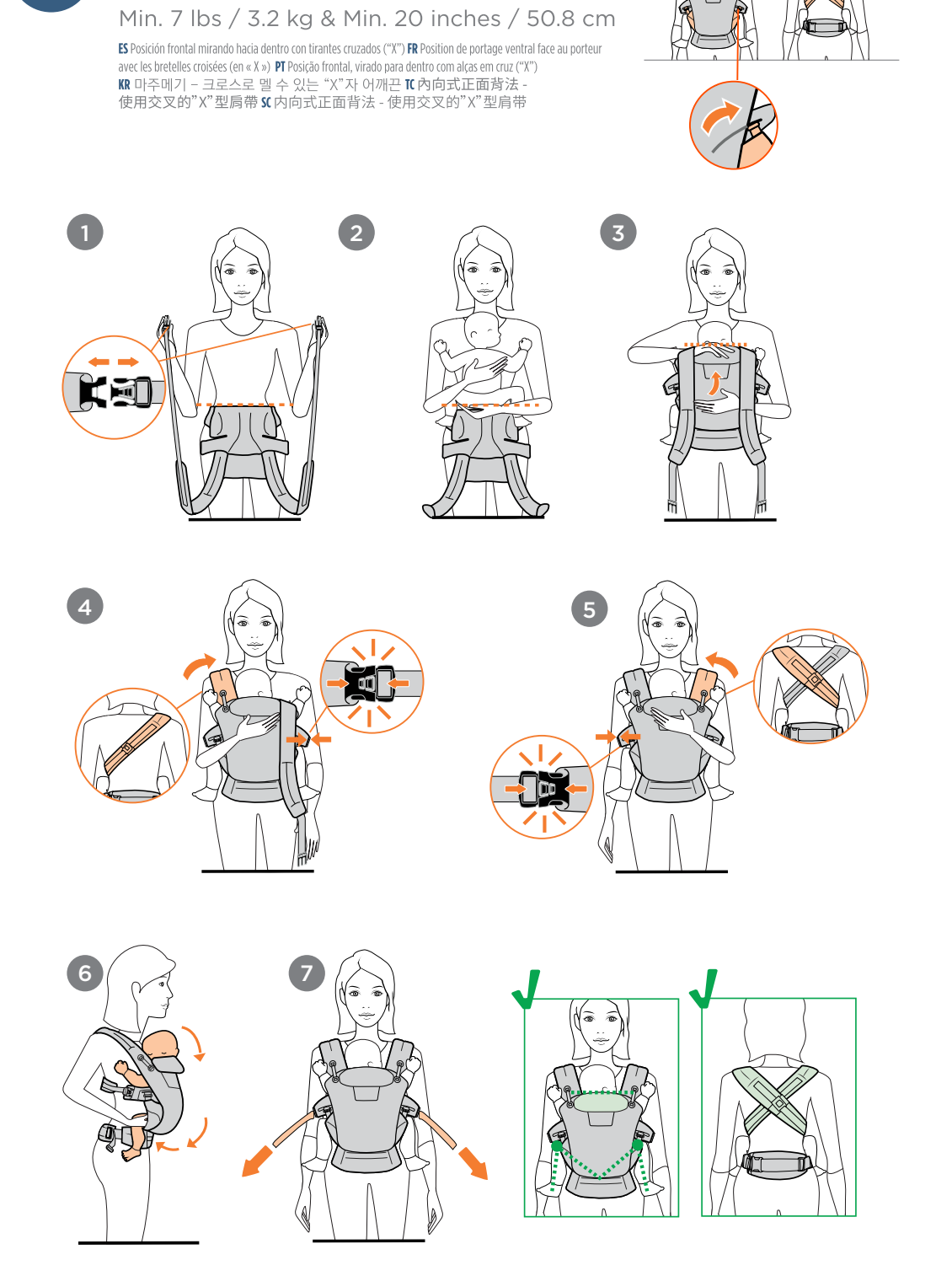
1D Loosen both shoulder straps



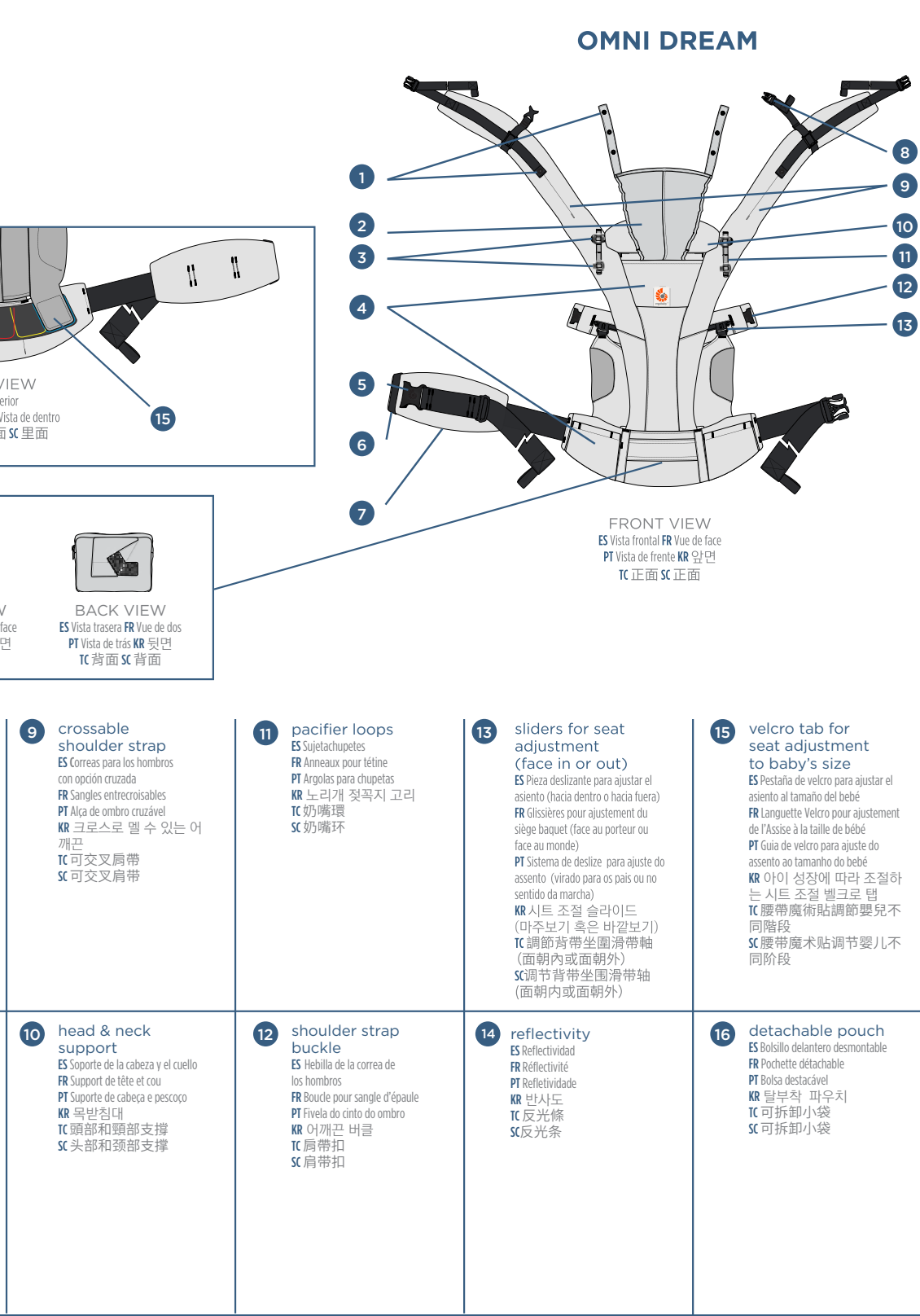
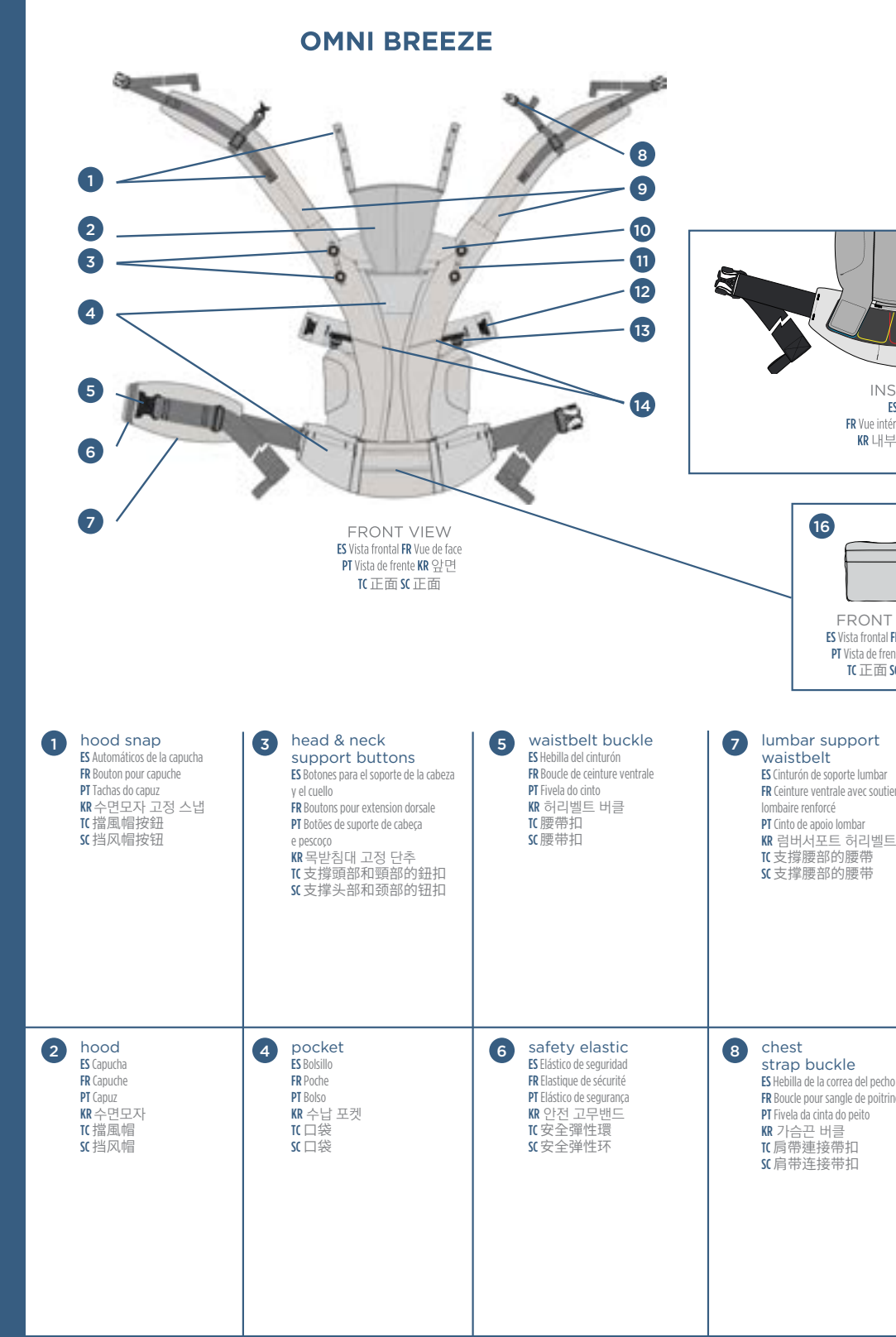
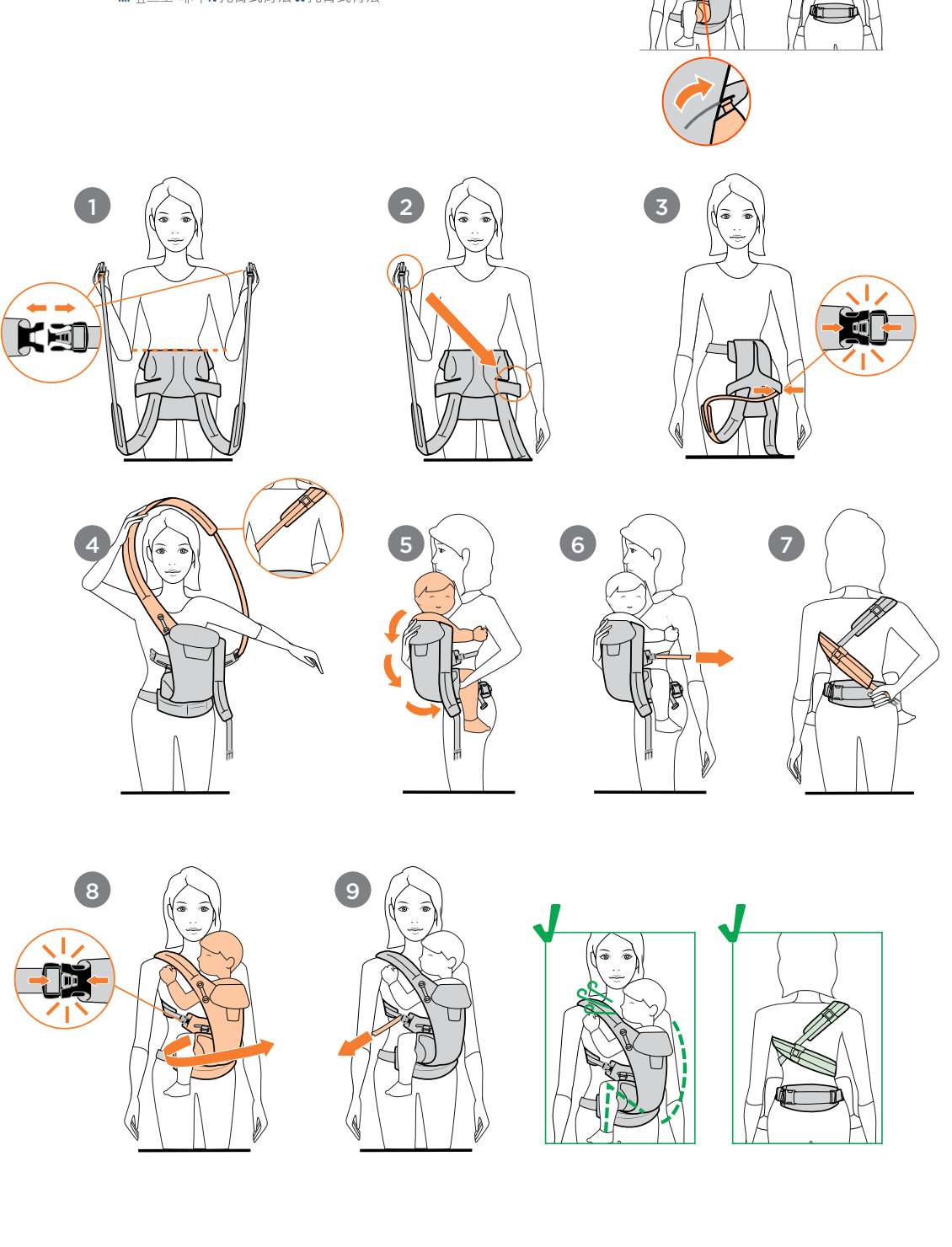
1E Push & Squeeze to unbuckle the shoulder straps if needed
